Hopefully the sun will stay out for our athletics days this week and next. We look forward to catching up with as many families as possible at these events.

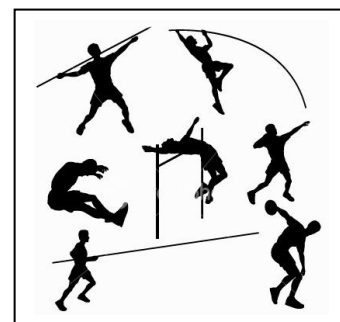
