Moana Composters

We recently received funding from the Seagull Centre Thames for two projects: Guardianship of Burke Street Stream and Kuranui Bay and Community Composting System.

The funding comes from the 2022 Seagull Centre 'Local Community Funding Grants' round and will allow our students to engage and participate in these environmental projects while connecting with our local community and organisations.

Our composting project is called Moana Composters and the project is starting to take shape. We will soon be sending out information about how you can become involved at home and contribute to this system.

You will get a container to keep at home and fill with all your kitchen scraps. When it is full, bring it in to school and swap it for a clean one. We will compost your kitchen scraps in our compost bins.
