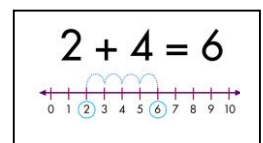


Toys at School

Toys from home are not to be brought to school as they can get damaged, and cause distraction and conflict in class.

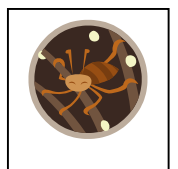
Prime Maths Books

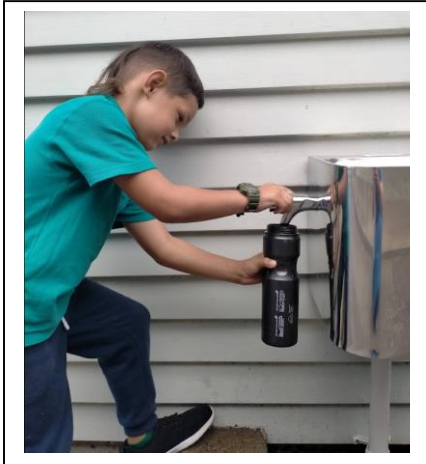

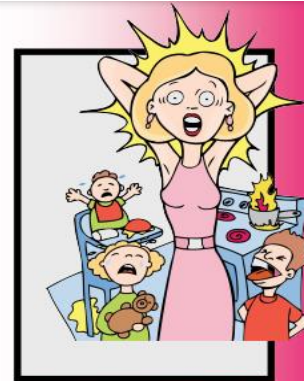
This swimming bag was left hanging on a fence in Queen St on 16th February just before school was due to start. Does it belong to one of our students?
