We are celebrating Matariki this week and have a great line-up of events and activities planned.

Matariki is a significant celebration in the New Zealand Curriculum, promoting understanding of Māori astronomy, cultural traditions, and values. This unit incorporates cross-curricular learning with a focus on Social Sciences, Science, and The Arts, culminating in the creation and flying of kites (manu tukutuku). Including a hakari, kī-o-rahi practice, and the game pūkana enriches the experience, fostering community and student engagement.

We will be creating star-themed artwork today, planting a tree tomorrow, making kites on Wednesday, and having a shared lunch on Thursday.

**Please bring kai to share on Thursday for lunch at 12.30,** which can be left in our school kitchen in the morning.







We will hold a whole-school hui after lunch on Thursday with a kapa-haka performance, story-telling, waiata, then finishing our celebration with kite flying at 2pm.

Danielle Hutchinson and Debbie Roath are coming to work with the students on Wednesday lunch times but the students entering will need to be practicing each day.


They can practice at lunchtimes in room 8 also. Please make sure your child's entry fee of \$8 is paid as soon as possible as the event is on Tuesday 24th June.


There will be a note home this week to see who can help with transport to and from the event.





