### KIWIBANK IN TROUBLE FOR OVERCHARGING 19.6.24

Kiwibank should never be overcharging customers. Kiwibank has apologised for errors that led to overcharging more than 36,000 customers a total of \$7 million. The bank reported this situation and it ended with 21 criminal charges. Kiwibank has no right to be overcharging. Anne Callinan explained that these charges were due to multiple mistakes in Kiwibank's systems, causing the bank to misrepresent what customers owed. The true outcome of this situation is that we are paying more than we need. Hopefully Kiwibank can sort this situation out soon.

## NZ is Stopping Free Flu Vaccines for Children 18.6.24

The New Zealand government is stopping free flu vaccines for children which I think is a horrible idea especially because everything nowadays is getting so expensive. Did you know that in 2022 and 2023 flu vaccines were free for all children aged six months to 12 years? However, in 2024, the policy reverted to only providing free vaccines to children with significant respiratory illnesses or other high-risk medical conditions. This decision is expected to seriously affect children living in poverty and those at higher risk of severe illness. Influenza is a major cause of preventable hospitalisations among children under 14 in New Zealand. Children in poorer areas are three times more likely to be hospitalised due to lung infections. And this needs to change now! I think that this is a horrible idea for families struggling with financial problems.
