They can practice at lunchtimes in room 8 also.

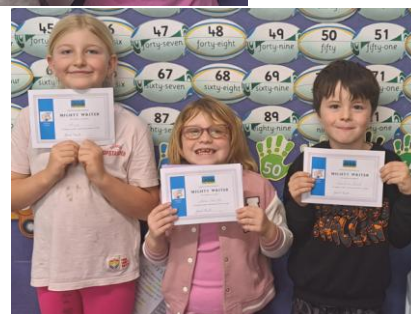
Please make sure your child's entry fee of \$8 is paid as soon as possible as the event is on the Tuesday 24th of June.
