# PARENT/CAREGIVER CONFERENCES THURSDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2024

We take the opportunity of meeting with parents and caregivers at this time of the year to discuss your child's progress. This also offers the teachers the best way to find out any important information which may affect your child's learning. Each conference will be **10 minutes** duration. If you want more time, please make a further appointment with your child's teacher. **Please endeavour to be on time as any delay affects others and your interview may be shortened**. A bell will ring to start each new 10 minute period.

We will send reports home on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April. **Please bring your child's report and your child** to the conference.

If you are not able to access SkoolLoop please fill in the form at the back of this note and return the form to the office as soon as possible. Conference times will be confirmed and returned home the same day a time is booked. We will attempt to give a time as close as possible to your request.
