JOHN DRUMMOND – DIRECTOR, SET DESIGNER, LIGHTING DESIGNER

John is a very experienced, ZONY Award winning Director (Spamalat). Other ZONY awards include Best Musical (Spamalat), Best Youth Production (The Wiz) and Best Lighting Design (Into the Woods). He has also received Nominations for Best Set Design (Oliver, Into the Woods, Beauty and the Beast, Addams Family), Best Make up Design (The Wiz), Best Lighting Design (Oliver, Spamalat, Beauty and the Beast, West Side Story, Mamma Mia), Best Staging (Oliver, The Wiz, Into the Woods, Addams Family, Mamma Mia), Best Youth Production (Into the Woods, West Side Story) and Best Director (Beauty and the Beast, Addams Family, Mamma Mia).

John has been involved in over 115 productions having directed over 65 of them. As well as directing he usually does the set and lighting designs for his productions. He is a very versatile director with production ranging from farces and murder mysteries through to rock opera and grand opera.
