#### **Edge Mobile App**

Edge is the name of the student management system we use here at school.

Edge has an app that can be used **for reporting student absences,** and also for **booking appointments** for student learning conferences.

Please download our school app asap, Edge, available from both the Apple App Store and Google Play Store.

You'll need this app to book for the upcoming Learning Conferences on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> November.

It's also a convenient way to view your child's school reports, and to report absences directly to the school.

Please note that our school is not currently using the Financials and Live Reporting sections of the app.

If you haven't already, download *Edge* today so you're ready to make your Learning Conference bookings! Once you have downloaded the app, look for the Moanataiari School web links and click on Appointments. This will take you to the Parent portal. From here you can book in for a learning conference.

#### **Interschool Athletics**


A big **congratulations** to all those students who took part in the Interschool Athletics at Thames High School last Friday. The weather was fabulous and we had a great day.
