Can your child please bring a good lunch, snacks and a big named drink bottle as it will be big days for them at the Civic Centre. No food that needs heating, please.


The Matinee is at 11.00 am on Wednesday the 29th of November. The schools in the area have been invited to this and it is also open for anyone to come.


