# Christmas Parade 2022



Dear Families,

If your child wishes to join us to represent Moanataiari School at the Christmas Parade on Saturday, the 17th of December 2022, **please sign the below slip and return it to school as soon as possible**.

The **new start point** is at the **corner of Cochrane and Pollen Street**. The parade will begin at 11.00 a.m. and will **end at Thames South School** / Te Kura o Te Kauaeranga Grey Street field entrance. There will be activities to enjoy at the end of the parade.

Students are to **meet the float at the starting point at 10.30 a.m.** and will need to be collected immediately after the parade finishes at Thames South School. Children will not be allowed to leave to find their families. Families must collect students from a staff member at the float.

Parents are welcome to join. Please dress up in our theme (beach attire) and be prepared to walk alongside our float and help supervise students.

The children's outfit for the float is beach attire/Hawalian shirts; shorts; sunscreen/zinc must be applied, and sunhats are worn. They are encouraged to bring goggles, snorkels, buckets, spades etc. It would be wise to name personal items.

Younger students will be placed on the truck, and older students may need to walk behind the truck. Please ensure suitable footwear is used on the day.
