

Swimming Lessons Are Back

Block lessons are running this coming school holidays, from the 10th - 14th October from 9am.


Three days per week, two hours per day as a teacher aide at Moanataiari School. Please contact the Principal on principal@moana.school.nz by Friday 9th Sept.

Tetrapak recycling opening soon at the Seagull Centre

Liquid paperboard cartons, such as soy milk cartons, UHT milk, etc will soon be able to be recycled into building board products.

On a trial basis, starting this week, we will be collecting these cartons at our school office then take them over to the Seagull Centre.

The cartons MUST be cut open to lie flat, washed clean and dried thoroughly before being left at our school office. Carton caps can be left screwed onto the carton.

20 SPOT PRIZES - to be won across all ages so everyone gets a chance. These will include Subway vouchers & movie vouchers.


